Welcome back

It has been wonderful to have our students back this week, it has been great for our staff to reconnect too. We are constantly reinforcing our school values as part of the way we do things at Waitakere Primary. This week our focus is on Respect - Manaakitanga. It is important that together we are reinforcing our school values both at home and school and talking with our children around how and what these might look like on a day to day basis in a range of contexts.

We are very excited that sometime in the next 2 weeks we will commence the refurbishment of rooms 21 & 22, students from these rooms will be relocated to the hall while this work is being undertaken. This will make these learning spaces much more pleasant for both students and teachers. We will then be moving on to rooms 14 & 15 and then 7 & 8. This means that the hall will not be able to be used for basketball practise for the remainder of the year.


