
Important Reminders re Level 2

The Government has advised that schools are safe for all to return. However, we do ask you to heed the advice that if your child is sick, please keep them at home.

For schools, Level 2 is pretty much business as usual taking into account the key principles for this level:

- Reducing the risk of someone getting infected our school will be practising good hygiene practices as advised by the Ministry of Health
- Ensuring that we can identify and contact anyone who becomes infected visitors (including whanau and family) to our school site will be required to complete a contact register.

Please make sure your child has a named water bottle for them to use at school. At this stage we are not participating in team sports – e.g. basketball and netball. We will await the government announcement on May 25th re social gatherings and group sizes and re-evaluate the situation.

The annual CAM Kiwi English, Mathematics and Science competitions are skills-based and closely aligned with the New Zealand Curriculum. The tests are designed by New Zealand teachers for New

Information for Parents - Accessing practice materials and past papers from CAM

Current and historical test papers and competitions are not made available to the public. Test papers/items are not made available to parents. Reasons for withholding are outlined within the Official Information Act section 9(2) 'Other reasons for withholding official information', and in particular in reference to preventing the disclosure or use of official information for improper gain or improper advantage, and to protect the commercial position of CAM.

The tests are administered online and take 50 minutes to complete so they can be conveniently slotted into the school timetable.

Prices: The cost per student for each competition is \$9.00 (incl. GST).

Reporting of results: Results are provided to schools in Term 3. Prizes will be awarded for each competition and year level. Certificates for each student will be sent to the school and prizes will be awarded to top students.
