#### 2020 Student Achievement

I think we would all agree 2020 was certainly a year we would all like to forget. Our students spent almost a term learning online and Term 4 was the only uninterrupted term we had. It is therefore pleasing to note that despite these challenges our students continue to achieve well. Last year:

- In writing 81% of our students achieved at and above expectation
- In maths 82% of our students achieved at and above expectation
- In reading 90% of our students achieved at and above expectation

Achievement was limited to the core curriculum areas, with students showing awesome development of their self-management skills.
